Activities for this recognition were developed as a Gold Award project by Senior Girl Scout on Okinawa. Complete 6 of the following activities. Be sure to choose at least 1 from each section.

DISCOVER	
	<b>Clothing</b> – Learn about the local traditional clothing. Visit a store or shop that sells traditional clothing. Or have someone teach you how to wear the traditional clothing.
	<b>Crafts</b> - Learn how to make three (3) hand-made crafts native to the country in which you live.
	<b>Learn the Language</b> – Learn several useful phrases in Japanese, Okinawan, or Korean. Practice using them on a troop field trip to a local site.
CONNECT	
	<b>Religion</b> – Visit a temple or shrine. Find out what religion worships at the site and at least two things about that particular religion.
	<b>Holidays and Festivals</b> – Learn about one of the Japanese, Korean, or Okinawan holidays or festivals and participate in the celebration.
	<b>Local Crafts</b> – Visit a local factory or craft site. Find out what is made there and watch it being made.
TAKE ACTION	
	<b>Cook</b> - Make a traditional Japanese, Korean, or Okinawan dish. Share your cooking and recipe with your troop or family.
	<b>History</b> - Visit one of the memorials or historic sites and learn why it is important.
	<b>Traditional Dolls</b> – Learn about the dolls in Japan, Okinawa, or Korea, and then make one.
