

USAGSO Council of Advisors Member Responsibilities

Purpose

The USA Girl Scouts Overseas Council of Advisors will support the work of USAGSO in fundraising, marketing/public relations and day-to-day operations and will provide input on matters of policy that directly concern the delivery of the Girl Scout program overseas. All members of the USAGSO Council of Advisors are expected to use their expertise and experience to support and advise USA Girl Scouts Overseas.

Responsibilities

- Act with care and loyalty to USAGSO by becoming familiar with the operations and policy of USAGSO and GSUSA and this Council of Advisors
- Be prepared, attend, and actively participate in all Council of Advisors meetings
- Be a working member of at least one (1) committee; be prepared, attend, and actively participate on all committees as assigned
- Be willing to lead Council of Advisors committees
- Share equal say and voting power with all other members
- Maintain open dialogue with other Council of Advisors members and committee members as assigned
- Maintain awareness of Girl Scout activities in the member's local area/region, attending and participating in events as available/will endeavor to liaise with local Girl Scout activities as possible
- Share guidance and expertise with the Council of Advisors
- Identify, cultivate, and recruit future Council of Advisors members
- Assist Council Development Committee with training and onboarding of new members
- Make committee appointment recommendations to the chair
- Each member of the Council of Advisors shall make an annual cash donation to USAGSO.
- Be an ambassador for the Girl Scout movement at all times
- Be (or become) a registered Girl Scout
